Description

Welcome aboard Amazon, a beautifully presented 36ft traditional stern narrowboat, built in 1992 by Dave Clarke Boat Builders. Compact yet thoughtfully laid out, she combines character, practicality, and comfort, making her an ideal choice for leisure cruising or as a manageable liveaboard.

The galley has been cleverly designed to make the most of the available space, offering everything needed for life on the water. It features a separate under-counter oven and grill, a four-burner integrated gas hob, and a 12v Shoreline fridge with freezer compartment. A stainless steel sink with drainer adds practicality, while a generous range of cupboards and drawers provide ample storage for provisions and kitchenware.

Moving through to the saloon, the space is warm and inviting, designed with versatility in mind. Bench seating easily converts into a comfortable double bed, with useful storage compartments tucked neatly underneath. Floor sockets allow for a removable dining table, offering the option of a dining or social area when needed. The Morso multifuel stove provides a cosy focal point and ensures comfort all year round, while a dedicated TV shelf completes this homely space.

The bathroom is neatly appointed and well equipped, featuring a bath with an overhead shower, a sink set within a vanity unit, a cassette toilet, and a heated towel rail. Everything has been arranged for convenience without sacrificing comfort.

The flexible layout of Amazon allows the saloon to double as a bedroom, making the most of the boat's proportions while still providing a practical and welcoming environment.

With her traditional stern, solid craftsmanship by Dave Clarke Boat Builders, and a layout that places the bathroom at the stern, followed by the galley and saloon, Amazon is well-suited for both relaxed cruising and extended stays afloat.
