Inside, the galley is both functional and spacious, providing all you need to cook and dine aboard. It features generous wall and base unit storage, durable laminate worktops, and a smart stainless-steel sink with a mixer tap. For meal preparation, there's a double oven, 4-ring gas hob, and a fridge with ice box—ensuring you can keep your groceries fresh and your crew well-fed during your travels.

Moving forward, the saloon is a light and airy space with ample room to relax. A large sofa bed offers flexible sleeping arrangements for guests, while a fitted unit provides storage and a dedicated space for a TV or entertainment setup. The area is kept warm and cosy by a full-sized radiator, and energy-efficient LED lighting creates a soft, ambient glow in the evenings. Double doors lead to the well deck, allowing plenty of natural light and offering an inviting connection to the outdoors.

The bedroom is located at the stern and boasts a fixed double bed with ample under-bed storage, making clever use of space. A built-in wardrobe with drawers below adds further practicality, helping to keep clothes and personal items neatly stored away. The bathroom is compact yet smartly designed, offering everything needed for daily comfort. It features a walk-in shower enclosure, a washbasin set into a vanity unit with storage below, and wall shelving for toiletries and towels.
