Description

November Rain is a delightful and welcoming 50ft cruiser stern narrowboat, built in 1998 and beautifully presented in the ever-popular reverse layout. Offering comfortable 2-berth accommodation and a bright, homely interior, she is well suited to both leisure cruising and full-time life afloat. Built and fitted out by Pat Buckle, she combines quality craftsmanship with thoughtful modern improvements.

Significant recent works have been completed, with the internal base plate fully treated, freshly repainted, and fitted with new flooring throughout in 2023/2024, giving the interior a fresh and well-maintained feel. She was blacked in 2022 and benefits from a full survey completed in 2024, offering added confidence to prospective buyers. Equipped with 12v electrics, shoreline hookup, and a 1000w Prosine inverter, November Rain is well prepared for comfortable onboard living whether moored or cruising. She is powered by a Perkins 4-cylinder engine paired with a PRM Newage Delta 20 gearbox, delivering reliable performance on the water.

Entering from the cruiser stern, you step directly into the galley. This practical and well-laid-out space includes a pantry, sink and drainer, ample cupboard storage, a 12v fridge/freezer, and a four-ring gas hob – everything needed for easy onboard cooking and extended stays.

Moving forward into the saloon, the space feels cosy yet functional. A sofa bed provides additional flexibility, while overhead cupboards and a corner shelving unit offer useful storage. A TV unit with television is already in place, and a multi-fuel stove creates a warm and inviting focal point, perfect for cooler evenings afloat.

The bathroom is neatly arranged and features a cassette toilet, vanity unit with sink, storage cupboards, and a hip bath with overhead shower – offering both practicality and comfort within a well-designed space.

At the bow, the bedroom provides a comfortable double bed with underbed storage, a slim drawer unit, and a TV positioned at the base of the bed. A right-hand door leads directly out to the bow, creating a lovely private retreat and an additional access point to enjoy waterside views.

With its smart reverse layout (stern, galley, lounge, bathroom, bedroom, bow), recent upgrades, and solid mechanical specification, November Rain presents a fantastic opportunity to step aboard a well-cared-for narrowboat ready for her next chapter.
